Dear Families,

This letter is to inform our student's families that Northern Local Schools have recently teamed up with Thompkins Child and Adolescent Services Inc. The goal in this collaboration is for the students to be able to not only succeed academically, but emotionally, socially and behaviorally as well.



**With this collaboration:** After the student receives an assessment, Thompkin's staff will be able to provide students services in the school building. This will help prevent the students from having to be transported from the school to the Thompkin's office and back when appointments are necessary.

The services that are available include: One on one student support, various groups that include social skills, self esteem, anger management, and groups that cover issues such as peer relationships and bullying.

Your student is not required to participate in these services. These services are being offered to students who may be struggling in the areas of academics due to possible social, emotional or behavioral health issues.

Thompkins staff will coordinate with parents, so that parents are aware of progress or concerns. Parents are encouraged to participate through frequent contact with Thompkins staff. This can occur at the school, Thompkins office, in the home or over the telephone/ email.
