Prepare to return to remote learning at any time due to Covid-19

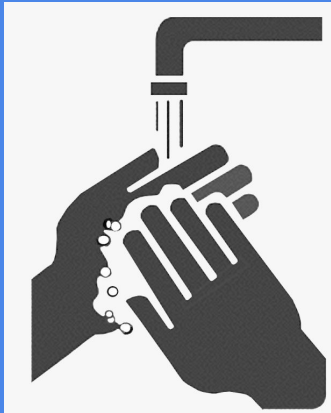

Academic & Social-Emotional Considerations



Attending to the social emotional well-being of our students will be a top priority as they return to school

*District and school staff are committed to supporting staff & students' social emotional wellness and offering resources to ensure students transition back to school smoothly. Support may include social emotional learning, building relationships, community- building activities and increased access to mental health/ wellness services. Families and schools will need to work together to monitor how students are feeling and assess their individual needs to provide the support they need during these challenging times.

*Principals, teachers, and counselors will monitor student grades to identify at-risk students. Principals will also monitor testing results to access both building and individual student needs. Principals and teachers will provide appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities with respect to the health and safety policies. NLSD will follow Board of Education policies regarding students with disabilities..

Operational Considerations



Resources

- Use current budgets and staff to the fullest extent while serving the needs of all students.
- Allocate ARP/ESSER funding to fill budget gaps through Sept. 30th, 2023.
- Keep disruptions to building assignments to a minimum while ensuring safety protocols.
- Maintain commitment to fiscal responsibility.

Facilities

- Continue to consider the guidelines set forth by ODH, ODE, and our local health departments to ensure safety and cleaning protocols.

Transportation

- Continue to consider guidance set forth by ODH, ODE, and our local health departments to provide the fullest extent of transportation possible with our buses.

Student Activities

- Provide extracurricular activities, such as sports, clubs, etc., as much as possible while considering guidance from ODH, ODE, OHSAA, and our local health departments.

Sanitation and Maintenance

- Restroom Cleaning - frequent cleaning of restrooms
- Contact Surfaces - wiping of frequently touched surfaces
- Barriers in Offices and Cafeteria - plexiglass dividers when appropriate
- Maintain bottle filling stations
- Prepackaged Food Items / Lunches and Breakfast grab-and-go
- Electrostatic cleaning sprayers using approved sanitation products
- Sanitation supplies in classrooms for cleaning of student spaces and classroom materials

Extra Curricular Activities

At the present time, athletics occur in accordance with state and local guidelines. We will continue to monitor guidance from ODE, ODH, OHSAA, and our local health departments to determine the appropriateness and viability of extra curricular options. These opportunities may be changed continually, as the guidelines for and levels of COVID -19 cases are shared.
