We are offering a **one-time \$500.00 scholarship** to one senior who meets the following criteria:

1. Be a high school senior graduating in 2022
2. Complete application
3. Attending a two or four year college for Fall of 2022
4. Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher
5. Must have played three full seasons of softball at the high school level
6. Must write a 250 word essay
  - a. “In your own words, tell us what you think the difference is between losing and getting beat”

Recipients will be chosen after applications and essays have been reviewed. The selected senior will need to provide proof of acceptance into a college or university and a fall semester/quarter schedule before receiving the monetary scholarship.
