

ASTRA Academic Hall of Excellence Criteria

- I. Criteria
 1. Engaged in their chosen career for ten or more years.
 2. Distinguished themselves as evidenced by honors or other recognition confirmed by their colleagues or associates.
 3. Recipients will be selected each year in the spring by the Hall of Excellence Committee.
 4. Graduated from schools that make up the Northern Local School District.

- II. The Hall of Excellence Committee will review itself each year at the spring meeting for any additions or deletions to the committee.

- III. Awards will be made at the National Honor Society Inductions each year.
 1. A dinner will precede the presentation. All National Honor Society members, Hall of Excellence members, and The Hall of Excellence Committee will be invited to attend. The dinner will be held at the high school and each new member invited to speak.
 2. The award will consist of a framed picture with credits added. The picture will be placed in the high school and a plaque with the credits given to the inductee.

- IV. Nominations will be made in the spring by the committee members. The nominees will remain on the ballot for a period of five years. After a five year period the nominees will be removed from the ballot unless they are renominated. Selections will also be made at this time by the Hall of Excellence Committee.
